"Sec. 4503.961. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 27
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other 28
vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles 29
may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle 30
and issuance of "Fairfield Senior High School" license plates. 31
The application may be combined with a request for a special 32
reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the 33
Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application and 34
compliance by the applicant with divisions (B) and (C) of this 35
section, the registrar shall issue to the applicant the 36
appropriate vehicle registration and a set of "Fairfield Senior 37
