"Sec. 4303.2011. (A) As used in this section: 9

(1) "Organization" means an association or employer of ten or more persons, a labor union, or a charitable organization. 10

(2) "Special function" means a function that has a social, recreational, benevolent, charitable, fraternal, political, patriotic, or athletic purpose. "Special function" does not include any function the proceeds of which are for the profit or gain of any individual. 12
