Minutes for October 15, 2019

The Senate Committee on Education was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 10:16 AM in the South Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

The roll was called and a quorum was present. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved without additions, corrections, or objections.

Chairwoman Lehner called up SB 102 for its 3rd hearing, proponent, opponent and interested party testimony. Chairwoman Lehner called upon Selina Oliver, with Pearson Clinical Assessment for her proponent testimony. Ms. Oliver answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner asked for a motion on acceptance of substitute bill 0645-6. Chairwoman Lehner asked that Senator Brenner explain the changes in proposed substitute bill. Senator Brenner gave an explanation. Senator Brenner made a motion to accept the substitute bill and Senator Gaverone seconded that motion. The Substitute bill was accepted.

Continuing testimony, Chairwoman Lehner called upon Amanda Stern for her proponent testimony. Ms Stern answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Marianne La Rosa with Language and Literacy Clinic for her proponent testimony. Ms. LaRosa answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Mike McGovern with IDA Central Ohio for his interested party testimony. Mr. McGovern answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Blythe Wood, Childrens Dyslexia Center for her interested party testimony. Ms. Wood answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Brett Tingley, OH-KID and UA-KID for his interested party testimony. Mr. Tingley answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Alvin Borromeo, with Dublin Dyslexia Parent Network for his interested party testimony. Mr. Borromeo answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called the Committee's attention to written testimony submitted from Mary Eisele and Diva Sridhar with MCGraw-Hill, Cheryl Kleist with Decoding Dyslexia OH, Neal Deryan with Chili Learning Center and Alejandro Rojas Silva on SB 102 for their review.

This concluded the 3rd hearing on SB 102.

Chairwoman Lehner called up Sub SB 89 for its 4th hearing, proponent, opponent, interested testimony. Chairwoman Lehner asked for a motion on acceptance of substitute bill 0729-2 Senator Brenner made the motion and it was seconded by Senator Coley. Chairwoman Lehner gave a brief summary of the Substitute bill.

Chairwoman Lehner made a motion to the Committee on Amendment number AM 1256. Senator Manning seconded the motion. Amendment does become part of the substitute bill.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Will Vorys, representing Career-Technical Education Association for his proponent testimony. No questions were asked by the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Dr. Jerry Farley for his proponent testimony. Dr. Farley answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman asked the pleasure of the Committee on voting on AM SUB SB 89. Senator Brenner made the motion to pass the bill out of Committee and it was seconded by Senator Coley. Roll call vote taken. AM SUB SB 89 was voted favorably out of Committee with a vote of 10-0.

Chairwoman Lehner called up SB 40 for its 3rd Hearing, proponent, opponent and interested party testimony. Chairwoman Lehner called upon Dr. David Jackson with Ohio Conference of the

American Association of the University Professors for his opponent testimony. Dr. Jackson answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman called upon Aaron Baer, with Citizens for Community Solutions for his proponent testimony. No questions were asked from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Gary Daniels with the ACLU for his interested party testimony. Mr. Daniels answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Bruce Johnson, President of the Inner University Council of Ohio for his opponent testimony. Mr. Johnson answered questions from the Committee.

This concluded the 3rd hearing on SB 40.

With no further business to come before the committee, Chairwoman Lehner adjourned the committee at approximately 1:11pm.
