

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Education Minutes
January 21, 2020
133rd General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Education was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 10:19 AM in the South Hearing Room of the Statehouse. The roll was called and a quorum was present. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved without additions, corrections, or objections.

Chairwoman Lehner called up HB 164 for its 1st hearing, sponsor testimony. Chairwoman Lehner called upon Representative Ginter for his sponsor testimony. Representative Ginter answered questions from the Committee.
With no further business on HB 164, this concluded the 1st hearing.

Chairwoman Lehner called up SB 102 for its 5th hearing, proponent, opponent and interested party testimony. Chairwoman Lehner asked for a motion to accept the substitute bill 0645-8. Motion by Senator Brenner and seconded by Senator Blessing. Without objection the substitute bill was accepted.
With no further business on Sub SB 102, this concluded the 5th hearing.

Chairwoman Lehner called up SB 200 for its 2nd hearing, proponent testimony. Chairwoman Lehner asked for a motion to accept the substitute bill 1555-3. Motion by Senator Brenner and seconded by Senator Blessing. Without objection the substitute bill was accepted.
Chairwoman Lehner called upon Holly Robbertz, with Olentangy School District, Dyslexia specialist for her proponent testimony. Ms. Robbertz answered questions from the committee.
Chairwoman Lehner called upon Genelle Eggerton, with Western Elementary Lexington Schools for her proponent testimony. Ms. Eggerton answered questions from the committee.
Chairwoman Lehner called upon Alida Sfalcin, retired teacher, for her proponent testimony. Ms. Sfalcin answered questions from the committee.
With no further business on Sub SB 200, this concluded the 2nd hearing.

Chairwoman Lehner called up HB 123 for its 3rd hearing, proponent, opponent and interested party testimony. Chairwoman Lehner asked for a motion to accept the substitute bill 0672-7. Motion by Senator Brenner and seconded by Senator Blessing. Without objection the substitute bill was accepted.
Chairwoman Lehner called upon Chris Dorr, Ohio Gun Owners, for his opponent testimony. There were no questions from the Committee.
Chairwoman Lehner made notice of written only testimony submitted to the Committee from: Scott DiMauro, OEA proponent testimony
