

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Education Minutes
June 24, 2020
133rd General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Education was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 4:49 PM in the Finance Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

The roll was taken and a quorum was present. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved without additions, corrections, or objections.

Chairwoman Lehner called up SB 320 for its Second Hearing.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Scott DiMauro with OEA for his opponent testimony. Mr. DiMauro answered questions from the committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Melissa Cropper with the Ohio Federation of Teachers for her opponent testimony. The committee asked no question.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Dr. Eugene Saunders with Ohio Mid-Sized Urban Districts Leadership Collaborative for his interested party testimony. Dr. Saunders answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Tony Podojil with The Alliance for High Quality Education for his interested party testimony. Mr. Podojil answered questions from the Committee.

Chairwoman Lehner made note of three written only interested party testimony from Stephen Dyer with Innovation Ohio, Kevin Miller with BASA and Jennifer Hogue with OSBA.

This ended the second hearing on SB 320.

Chairwoman Lehner called up HB 123 for the sixth hearing.

Chairwoman Lehner brought up AM 2968 for consideration. Chairwoman Lehner then explained the amendment. The Chairwoman asked for motion from the Committee and was seconded by Senator Brenner. Without objection, amendment number 2968 becomes part of the bill.

Chairwoman Lehner called upon Senator Brenner to explain amendment number 2969-2. The Committee asked no questions.

With no further business to come before the committee, Chairwoman Lehner adjourned the committee at approximately 5:46 PM
