Subject: Please support SB 234

We live in Seneca County, OHIO within the proposed Seneca Wind Project Footprint. They have proposed that we could have 2 wind turbines within a ¼ mile of our home in Bloom Township, plus **many** more in Bloom Township and the surrounding area.

We purchased our home here almost 30 years ago, so we can live in an area where we can listen to the outside nature, the creek rolling by, crickets, and the "stillness". A place we can take long quiet walks and enjoy our surroundings. We so enjoy this at our home.

We see the bats in the evening that eat the insects, eagles perched on trees, deer roaming the fields, birds at our feeders. That is part of the reason we **CHOSE** to live here. We are very concerned about Seneca Wind Projects effects on our county airport. Allowing an outside corporation to degrade its safety and usefulness is not acceptable. **We are also extremely concerned about the safety hazards the turbines will cause air ambulances and agricultural aerial application in and near the project.**
