

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Government Oversight and Reform Minutes**  
**February 26, 2019**  
**133rd General Assembly**

The Senate Committee on Government Oversight and Reform was called to order at 10:08a.m. in the Finance Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The minutes were approved without objection.

Chairman Coley called up S.B. No. 10 for its first hearing sponsor testimony. The following testimony was provided:

Senator Huffman moved that S.B. 53 be favorably reported to the Rules and Reference Committee. Senator Hoagland seconded the motion. With a vote of 8 to 3, S.B. 53 was favorably reported to the Rules and Reference Committee.
