

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Government Oversight and Reform Minutes**  
**April 2, 2019**  
**133rd General Assembly**

The Senate Committee on Government Oversight and Reform was called to order at 3:25 p.m. in the South Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Senator Huffman moved that S.B. 52 be favorably reported to the Rules and Reference Committee. Senator Roegner seconded the motion. With a vote of 11 to 0, S.B. 52 was favorably reported to the Rules and Reference Committee.
