

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Government Oversight and Reform Minutes**  
**May 7, 2019**  
**133rd General Assembly**

The Senate Committee on Government Oversight and Reform was called to order at 3:32 p.m. in the South Hearing Room of the Statehouse.
