

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Higher Education Minutes
October 30, 2019
133rd General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Higher Education was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 10:04 a.m. in the North Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken with a quorum present. The Committee proceeded to its first order of business.
