

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Insurance and Financial Institutions Minutes
September 1, 2020
133rd General Assembly

Senator Hackett called the Senate Insurance and Financial Institutions committee to order at 10:15 am.

Roll was called, a quorum was present, and the minutes from the previous meeting were agreed to.

First order of business were Governor's Appointment, Vice-Chairman Hottinger moved to send the appointments to the committee on rules and reference. The motion passed without objection.

Next, Senator Hackett called the Administrator of the Bureau of Workers Compensation appointment of Patricia Harris, Vice-Chairman Hottinger moved to send the appointment to the committee on rules and reference. The motion was passed without objection.

Chairman Hackett called H.B 339 for a 4th hearing. Chairman Hackett offered amendment number 3057 and explained the amendment. With no objections the amendment was added to the bill.

Vice-chairman Hottinger motioned to favorably report Sub. H.B. 339 to the Senate Rules and Reference committee. The motion was agreed to by a vote of 13-0.

Senator Hackett called HB 38 for a second hearing. Senator Blessing offered amendment 2580, the amendment was accepted without objection.
