

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
March 27, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present or checked in.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Dolan moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Peterson seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was reports of appointments by the Governor to committees: Agriculture - Finance - Government Oversight and Reform - Health, Human Services and Medicaid - Judiciary. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Williams moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Wilson seconded the motion. The Advise and Consent report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, March 27, 2019. Senator Dolan moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator M. Huffman seconded the motion. The Reference Report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The fourth order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, March 27, 2019:

The Chair called up S.B. No. 4 (Rulli/Kunze) Make capital appropriations for school facilities assistance.
Senator Thomas moved S.B. No. 4, seconded by Senator O'Brien. S.B. No. 4 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 7 (Lehner/Hackett) Regards temporary occupational licensing for military.
Senator Williams moved S.B. No. 7, seconded by Senator Dolan. S.B. No. 7 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 27 (Uecker) Regards disposition of fetal remains from surgical abortion.
Senator Eklund moved S.B. No. 27, seconded by Senator M. Huffman. S.B. No. 27 was referred to the floor by a vote of 10-4 (Senators Yuko, Thomas, O'Brien and Williams voting no).

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Coley moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion.
Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
