S. B. No. 45 – Senator Hackett

To enact section 5.2514 of the Revised Code to designate the month of April as "Ohio Native Plant Month."

(Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources recommends passage April 11, 2019)

To amend sections 2929.17, 2953.32, and 2953.36 and to enact section 2950.151 of the Revised Code to create a procedure for certain offenders convicted of unlawful sexual conduct with a minor to petition a court for reclassification or removal from duties under the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Law and to permit record sealing in those cases.

(Committee on Judiciary recommends passage of substitute bill April 10, 2019)

To amend section 2933.32 of the Revised Code to authorize a corrections officer to cause a body cavity search to be conducted or to conduct a strip search and to establish separate rules for conducting strip searches.

To amend sections 2925.01 and 2925.03 of the Revised Code to enhance penalties for certain drug trafficking offenses committed in the vicinity of a substance addiction services provider and to name the act's provisions the "Relapse Reduction Act."

To amend sections 2909.07, 2909.10, 2911.21, 2911.211, 2917.21, and 2917.32 and to enact section 2307.67 of the Revised Code to modify certain criminal offenses with respect to critical infrastructure facilities and to impose fines and civil liability for damage to a critical infrastructure facility.

(Committee on Judiciary recommends passage May 1, 2019)

S. B. No. 120 – Senators McColley, Rulli

To amend section 117.46 of the Revised Code to authorize the Auditor of State to conduct performance audits of any and all state institutions of higher education.

To enact section 5.078 of the Revised Code to designate the *Dunkleosteus terrelli* as the official state fossil fish.
