Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
April 10, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Huffman moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Williams seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was reports to committees of appointments by the Governor: Agriculture and Natural Resources - Energy and Public Utilities - Finance. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Hottinger moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Dolan seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, April 10, 2019. Senator Wilson moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Williams seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 31 (Roegner) Exempt EMS telecommunicator info from Public Records Law.

Senator Yuko moved S.B. No. 31, seconded by Senator O'Brien. S.B. No. 31 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 48 (Eklund) Narrows the scope of speedy trial rules.

Senator Peterson moved S.B. No. 48, seconded by Senator Huffman. S.B. No. 48 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 77 (Hoagland/Williams) Designate Women Veterans' Day.

Senator Williams moved S.B. No. 77, seconded by Chairman Obhof. S.B. No. 77 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 108 (Obhof) Eliminate rule of construction on determining legislative intent.

Senator Eklund moved S.B. No. 108, seconded by Senator Huffman. S.B. No. 108 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.
