

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
May 1, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Williams moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Kunze seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were approved without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was reports of Governor's appointments to committees: Agriculture and Natural Resources - Higher Education - Finance - General Government and Agency Review - Government Oversight and Reform - Insurance and Financial Institutions - Judiciary. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Wilson moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, May 1, 2019. Senator Dolan moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Williams seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The fourth order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, May 1, 2019:

The Chair called up S.B. No. 33 (Hoagland) Modify criminal and civil law for critical infrastructure damage.

Senator Huffman moved S.B. No. 33, seconded by Senator Coley. S.B. No. 33 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 45 (Hackett) Designate April as Ohio Native Plant Month.

Senator Burke moved S.B. No. 45, seconded by Senator Kunze. S.B. No. 45 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 120 (McColley/Rulli) Conduct performance audits of state higher ed institutions.

Senator Wilson moved S.B. No. 120, seconded by Senator O'Brien. S.B. No. 120 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 123 (Dolan/Manning) Designate *Dunkleosteus terrelli* as state fossil fish.

Senator O'Brien moved S.B. No. 123, seconded by Senator Eklund. S.B. No. 123 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Coley moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator Yuko seconded the motion.
