Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
May 8, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Yuko moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Williams seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was reports of appointments by the Governor to committees: Finance - Insurance and Financial Institutions. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Wilson moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Williams seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, May 8, 2019:

The Chair called up S.B. No. 1 (McColley/Roegner) Reduce number of regulatory restrictions. Senator Burke moved S.B. No. 1, seconded by Senator Huffman. S.B. No. 1 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 26 (Kunze) Permit income tax deduction for certain teacher expenses. Senator Williams moved S.B. No. 26, seconded by Senator Peterson. S.B. No. 26 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 37 (Schuring) Extend eligibility for and revise the motion picture tax credit.

Senator Dolan moved S.B. No. 37, seconded by Senator Williams. S.B. No. 37 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 107 (Rulli) File certain campaign finance statements electronically. Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 107, seconded by Senator Coley. S.B. No. 107 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Coley moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator Hottinger seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
