Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
July 17, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Wilson moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Williams seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was reports to committees of appointments by the Governor: Education - Finance - Government Oversight and Reform - Transportation, Commerce and Workforce. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Burke moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. The fourth order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, July 17, 2019:

The Chair called up H.B. No. 6 (Callender/Wilkin) Creates Ohio Clean Air Program. Senator Eklund moved H.B. No. 6, seconded by Senator Williams. H.B. No. 6 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 50 (Greenspan) Declare certain hospital employee inventions property of Hospital. Senator Dolan moved H.B. No. 50, seconded by Senator Kunze. H.B. No. 50 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 13 (Fedor) Apply same human trafficking offenses to all victims under 18. Senator Williams moved S.B. No. 13, seconded by Senator Kunze. S.B. No. 13 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Coley moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator Thomas seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
