

Senator Obhof reports for the standing committee on Rules and Reference, recommending that the following bills and resolution, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

**Am. H. B. No. 172 – Representative Hillyer, et al.**

To amend sections 4513.601, 5322.01, 5322.02, and 5322.03 of the Revised Code to amend the law regarding self-service storage facilities and private tow-away zones.

To the Committee on Transportation, Commerce and Workforce.

**S. C. R. No. 5 – Senator Schaffer**

To urge the Congress of the United States to enact the Mark Takai Atomic Veterans Healthcare Parity Act.

To the Committee on Insurance and Financial Institutions.

**S. B. No. 186 – Senators Manning, Sykes**

To amend sections 3501.01, 3501.05, 3503.09, 3503.10, 3503.12, 3503.13, 3503.14, 3503.15, 3503.16, 3503.19, 3503.20, 3503.21, 3503.23, 3503.24, 3503.26, 3503.28, 3503.30, 3503.33, 3505.18, 3505.181, 3505.183, 3509.02, 3509.03, 3509.04, 3509.05, 3509.08, 3511.02, 3511.09, 3513.05, 3513.18, 3513.19, 3513.191, 3517.012, 3517.013, 3599.11, 3599.12, 3599.18, and 3599.36; to enact new sections 3503.11 and 3503.111 and sections 3503.112, 3503.22, and 3503.231; and to repeal sections 3503.11, 3503.111, and 3503.29 of the Revised Code to create a voter verification and registration system, to modify the requirements for the administration of the statewide voter registration database, and to allow electors to register as affiliated with a political party.

establishment licensure that applies to certain wineries.

To enact section 5534.829 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 39 in Holmes County as the "Cpl. Fredrick Wayne Miller Memorial Highway."
