Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
October 23, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Williams moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was reports to committees of appointments by the Governor: Energy and Public Utilities - Finance - Local Government, Public Safety and Veterans Affairs. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Attorney General. Senator M. Huffman moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Williams seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator O'Brien moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Burke seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The fourth order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, October 23, 2019. Senator Williams moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Eklund seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 189 (Patterson/Blessing) - Revise laws governing amusement ride operation and safety.

Senator Kunze moved H.B. No. 189, seconded by Senator Thomas. H.B. No. 189 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 58 (Gavarone) - Regards restoring competency for mentally ill charged with crime.

Senator Yuko moved S.B. No. 58, seconded by Senator Eklund. S.B. No. 58 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 59 (Antonio) Require pharmacist education regarding naloxone dispensing.

Senator O'Brien moved S.B. No. 59, seconded by Senator Wilson. S.B. No. 59 was referred to the

floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 89 (Huffman, M.) - Regards career-technical ed and JVSD in enterprise zones.

Senator Hottinger moved S.B. No. 89, seconded by Senator Dolan. S.B. No. 89 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 151 (Maharath) - Designate Maternal Mortality Awareness Month.

Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 151, seconded by Senator O'Brien. S.B. No. 151 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.
