

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
November 6, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Peterson moved that the minutes of the previous meeting be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator M. Huffman seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted as written.

The first order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Eklund moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Williams seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The second order of business was the re-referral of H.B. No. 10 (Brown, Stoltzfus) Establish Governor's Office of Drug Policy. Having been reported by the standing committee on General Government and Agency Review, be re-referred to the standing committee on Finance. Senator Wilson moved that H.B. No. 10 be re-referred, seconded by Senator Burke. H.B. No. 10 was re-referred by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, November 6, 2019. Senator Williams moved that report be referred to the floor. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The fourth order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, November 6, 2019:

No action was taken on the bill.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 276 (Ghanbari) Designate SEAL Edward C. Byers, Jr., Medal of Honor Recipient Hwy.
Senator Kunze moved H.B. No. 276, seconded by Senator O'Brien. H.B. No. 276 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 150 (Maharath) Designate Maternal Mental Health Awareness Week.
Senator Yuko moved S.B. No. 150, seconded by Senator Kunze. S.B. No. 150 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 155 (Lehner) Regards pretreatment notice of mifepristone abortion reversal.
Senator M. Huffman moved S.B. No. 155, seconded by Senator Coley seconded the motion. S.B. No. 155 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 181 (Coley) Create template for workforce-education partnership programs.
Senator Dolan moved S.B. No. 181, seconded by Senator Thomas. S.B. No. 181 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 192 (Craig) Designate Poindexter Village a state historic site. Senator O'Brien moved S.B. No. 192, seconded by Senator Kunze. S.B. No. 192 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 194 (Rulli) Regards voter registration system approval; candidate protests. Senator Wilson moved S.B. No. 194, seconded by Senator Eklund. S.B. No. 194 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 208 (Johnson) Regards child born alive after attempted abortion. Senator Burke moved S.B. No. 208, seconded by Senator Coley. S.B. No. 208 was referred to the floor by a vote of 10-4 (Senators Yuko, Thomas, O'Brien and Williams voting no).

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Coley moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
