

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
November 13, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes from the previous meeting. Senator Peterson moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Thomas seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted as written.

The first order of business was a report to committee of appointments by the Attorney General: Energy and Public Utilities. The report was properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Eklund moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Burke seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, November 13, 2019. Senator O'Brien moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Dolan seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

Senator Dolan moved H.B. No. 2, seconded by Senator O'Brien. H.B. No. 2 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 16 (Perales) - Grant state college residency status to military and dependents.
Senator O'Brien moved H.B. No. 16, seconded by Senator Kunze. H.B. No. 16 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 18 (Antonio/Lehner) - Prohibit restraining or confining pregnant female offender.
Senator Yuko moved S.B. No. 18, seconded by Senator Kunze. S.B. No. 18 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 173 (Kunze) - Designate Hirschsprung's Disease Awareness Month.
Senator Wilson moved S.B. No. 173, seconded by Senator Hottinger. S.B. No. 173 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Coley moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion.
