Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
December 11, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Williams moved that the minutes of the previous meeting be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Peterson seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted as written.

The first order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Eklund moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Wilson seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The second order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, December 11, 2019. Senator Yuko moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Williams seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 4 (Richardson/Robinson) - Develop industry-recognized credential and certificate programs.
Senator Thomas moved H.B. No. 4, seconded by Senator Dolan. H.B. No. 4 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 12 (Manning, D./West) - Create Children's Behavioral Health Prevention Network Group.
Senator Williams moved H.B. No. 12, seconded by Senator O'Brien. H.B. No.12 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 103 (Dolan/Yuko) - Grant Cleveland Housing Div-hear environmental pollution cases.
Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 103, seconded by Senator Thomas. S.B. No. 103 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 175 (Schaffer) - Grant civil immunity-injury, death, loss from carrying handguns.
Senator M. Huffman moved S.B. No. 175, seconded by Senator O'Brien. S.B. No. 175 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 195 (Schaffer) - Revise winery exemption from food establishment licensing.
Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 195, seconded by Senator O'Brien. S.B. No. 195 was referred to the

floor by a vote of 14-0.
