Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
December 17, 2019
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Williams moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Wilson seconded the motion. Hearing no objection, the minutes were accepted as written.

Senator Kunze moved S.C.R. No. 5, seconded by Senator M. Huffman. S.C.R. No. 5 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 165 (Schaffer) Establish requirements for SNAP electronic benefit transfer cards.

Senator Wilson moved S.B. No. 165, seconded by Senator Coley. S.B. No. 165 was referred to the floor by a vote of 9-3 (Senators Thomas, Williams and Yuko voting no).
