Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
January 22, 2020

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Wilson moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Thomas seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as written.

The first order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, January 22, 2020. Senator O'Brien moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Peterson seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The second order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, January 22, 2020:

Senator Burke moved H.B. No. 129, seconded by Senator Yuko. H.B. No. 129 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.
