

Senator Obhof reports for the standing committee on Rules and Reference, recommending that the following bills and resolution, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

S. R. No. 454 – Senator Roegner

To respectfully urge Congress and President Donald Trump to amend the Federal Clean Air Act to eliminate the requirement to implement the E-Check Program and direct the Administrator of USEPA to begin new rule-making procedures under the Administrative Procedures Act to repeal and replace the 2015 National Ambient Air Quality Standards; to respectfully urge Congress and President Donald Trump to pass legislation to achieve improvements in air quality more efficiently while allowing companies to innovate and help the economy grow; to urge the Administrator of USEPA to alleviate burdensome requirements of the E-Check Program and the Clean Air Act if Congress and the President fail to act; and to encourage OEPA to explore alternatives to E-Check in Ohio.

To amend sections 3301.0714, 3302.20, 3310.08, 3310.41, 3310.54, 3314.08, 3314.084, 3314.087, 3314.088, 3314.091, 3314.11, 3314.20, 3317.017, 3317.02, 3317.022, 3317.029, 3317.0212, 3317.0217, 3317.0218, 3317.0219, 3317.03, 3317.051, 3317.163, 3326.31, 3326.33, and 3326.42 and to repeal section 3310.55 of the Revised Code and to amend Sections 265.10, 265.170, 265.210, 265.220, 265.230, and 265.235 of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly to require the direct payment of state funding to community schools and science, technology, engineering, and mathematics schools; to require the direct payment of K-12 state scholarships; and to make an appropriation.
