Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
February 5, 2020
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Wilson moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Williams seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted as written.

The first order of business was reports to committees of appointments by the Governor: Agriculture and Natural Resources - Energy and Public Utilities - Finance - Government Oversight and Reform - Health, Human Services and Medicaid - Higher Education - Insurance and Financial Institutions - Judiciary - Transportation, Commerce and Workforce. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, February 5, 2020. Senator Burke moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Thomas seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, February 5, 2020:

The Chair called up S.B. No. 134 (Gavarone) Change law regarding passing school bus. Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 134, seconded by Senator O'Brien. S.B. No. 134 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 163 (Kunze) Create ALS Awareness license plate. Senator Peterson moved S.B. No. 163, seconded by Senator Yuko. S.B. No. 163 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Wilson moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
