

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes**  
**February 12, 2020**  
**133rd General Assembly**

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.  
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Yuko moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Wilson seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted as written.

The first order of business was reports to committees of appointments by the Governor: Energy and Public Utilities - Health, Human Services and Medicaid - Transportation, Commerce and Workforce. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, February 12, 2020. Senator Eklund moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Williams seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, February 12, 2020:

The Chair called up H.B. No. 158 (Blessing) Waive fee for indigent petitioning for limited driving privileges.

Senator Williams moved H.B. No. 158, seconded by Senator Thomas. H.B. No. 158 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 156 (Gavarone) Prohibits defrauding an alcohol, drug, or urine screening test.

Senator Thomas moved S.B. No. 156, seconded by Senator Eklund. S.B. No. 156 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 178 (Schuring) Regards podiatrist authority to administer flu vaccine. Senator M. Huffman moved S.B. No. 178, seconded by Senator Peterson. S.B. No. 178 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 220 (Manning) Designate Aortic Aneurysm Awareness Day.

Senator Wilson moved S.B. No. 220, seconded by Senator Burke. S.B. No. 220 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 236 (S. Huffman) Regards radiation control and radiation technology professionals.

Senator Dolan moved S.B. No. 236, seconded by Senator Coley. S.B. No. 236 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Coley moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator Kunze seconded the motion.

Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
