

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes**  
**May 20, 2020**  
**133rd General Assembly**

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.  
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Williams moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Burke seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted as written.

The first order of business was reports to committees of appointments by the Governor: Health, Human Services and Medicaid - Transportation, Commerce and Workforce.  
All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Eklund moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Wilson seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, May 20, 2020. Senator Thomas moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0 and the report was properly signed.

The fourth order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, May 20, 2020:

The Chair called up H.B. No. 81 (Perales) Regards post-diagnostics-prison guard exposed to bodily fluids.

Senator Dolan moved H.B. No. 81, seconded by Senator O'Brien. H.B. No. 81 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 203 (Lipps) Specifies requirements for mobile dental facility.  
Senator Wilson moved H.B. No. 203, seconded by Senator Thomas. H.B. No. 203 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 285 (Greenspan/Brent) Establish Driver's License Reinstatement Fee Debt Reduction Prog.

Senator Williams moved H.B. No. 285, seconded by Senator Kunze. H.B. No. 285 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 287 (Russo/Perales) Regards Medicaid waivers for relatives of active duty military.

Senator Eklund moved H.B. No. 287, seconded by Senator Williams. H.B. No. 287 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 248 (Schaffer) Extend moratorium on building code for school storm shelters.

Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 248, seconded by Senator O'Brien. S.B. No. 248 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 258 (Gavarone) Enters into the Psychology Interjurisdictional Compact.

Senator Wilson moved S.B. No. 258, seconded by Senator Dolan. S.B. No. 258 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 259 (Sykes) Authorizes the conveyance of state-owned real property. Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 259, seconded by Senator Thomas. S.B. No. 259 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Coley moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator Williams seconded the motion.

Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
