Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
May 27, 2020
133rd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Wilson moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Thomas seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were accepted as written.

The first order of business was the Advise and Consent Report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Dolan moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Burke seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The second order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, May 27, 2020. Senator Williams moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. The report was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0 and the report was properly signed.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 242 (Lang/D. Jones) Authorize use of auxiliary containers. Senator Williams moved H.B. No. 242, seconded by Senator O'Brien. H.B. No. 242 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 272 (Oelslager/Hillyer) Expand court jurisdiction to any constitutional basis. Senator Wilson moved H.B. No. 272, seconded by Senator Yuko. H.B. No. 272 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 126 (Manning) Authorize crisis assessments of suicidal minors without consent. Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 126, seconded by Senator O'Brien. S.B. No. 126 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 284 (Hottinger/Peterson) Amend law-insurers receiving credit for reinsurance. Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 284, seconded by Senator Burke. S.B. No. 284 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 309 (Gavarone) Permit swimming classes at private pool without pool license. Senator Kunze moved S.B. No. 309, seconded by Senator Hottinger. S.B. No. 309 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Coley moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
