

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes**  
**September 2, 2020**  
**133rd General Assembly**

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.  
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Burke moved that the minutes be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator O'Brien seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes were approved as written.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 364 (Manning) Designate Aortic Aneurysm Awareness Day. Senator Williams moved H.B. No. 364, seconded by Senator Kunze. H.B. No. 364 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 357 (Dolan) Distribute federal corona virus relief funding to local govts. Senator M. Huffman moved S.B. No. 357, seconded by Senator Yuko. S.B. No. 357 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.
