

Senator Obhof reports for the standing committee on Rules and Reference, recommending that the following bills and resolution, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

S. R. No. 552 – Senator Huffman, M., et al.

To urge the Big Ten Athletic Conference Commissioner to allow Big Ten member institutions to participate in athletic competitions for the 2020 fall season.

To the Committee on General Government and Agency Review.

S. B. No. 362 – Senator Peterson

To amend section 122.151 of the Revised Code to increase the total amount of tax credits that may be awarded to insurance companies that invest in rural business growth funds.

To the Committee on Insurance and Financial Institutions.

S. B. No. 363 – Senator Hoagland, et al.

To amend sections 4928.143, 4928.20, 4928.231, 4928.232, 4929.01, 4929.22, and 4929.29; to enact sections 4928.201 and 4929.271; and to repeal sections 4928.21 and 4929.26 of the Revised Code to eliminate automatic enrollment in governmental electric and natural gas aggregation programs.

S. B. No. 364 – Senator Roegner, et al.

To enact sections 4731.11 and 4731.111 of the Revised Code to enter into the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact.

S. B. No. 365 – Senator Fedor, et al.

To amend Section 12 of H.B. 197 of the 133rd General Assembly to extend the authorization for members of a public body to hold and attend meetings or hearings via electronic technology, during the period of the emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-01D on March 9, 2020, until the declared emergency is terminated.

S. B. No. 366 – Senator Williams, et al.

To enact section 2903.17 of the Revised Code to prohibit assault by a law enforcement officer.

S. B. No. 367 – Senator Brenner

To prohibit state institutions of higher education from requiring any student to reside in on-campus housing for the 2020-2021 school year and to declare an emergency.

S. B. No. 368 – Senator Brenner

To amend section 3301.07 of the Revised Code to require the use of phonics as the primary technique for teaching reading and writing in grades kindergarten through five and to make an appropriation.
