Committee on Transportation, Commerce and Workforce Minutes
January 22, 2020
133rd General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Transportation, Commerce, and Workforce was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 10:00 a.m. in the South Hearing Room of the Statehouse.
