Summary

- Requires the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission and the Department of Education to study the status of all school buildings eligible for school facilities funding regarding air conditioning, accessibility, school safety, and other amenities.
- Requires the Commission and the Department to submit their findings to the General Assembly no later than six months after the bill's effective date.

Detailed Analysis

Study regarding amenities available in school buildings

The bill requires the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission and the Department of Education to conduct a study on the status of all school buildings eligible for school facilities funding regarding air conditioning, accessibility, school safety, and any other amenity that the Commission and the Department determine should be available in school buildings. The Commission and the Department must submit their findings to the General Assembly no later than six months after the bill's effective date.¹
