



House Federalism and Interstate Relations Committee

Minutes: September 12, 2017

Chairwoman Roegner called the meeting to order at 2:30 PM. The roll was called and a quorum was present. The minutes from the July 5, 2017 meeting were approved without objection.

Chairwoman Roegner called House Bill 79 for its 3<sup>rd</sup> hearing.

Representative Retherford moved that the committee favorably report House Bill 79 out of committee. Chairwoman Roegner asked if there is any discussion. No discussion occurred. The clerk took the roll and House Bill 79 was favorably passed out of committee with a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays.

John Gilchrist of the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police submitted written testimony.

Chairwoman Roegner called House Bill 142 for its 5<sup>th</sup> hearing.

Representative Holmes moved that the committee accept Substitute House Bill 0494-3 as the new working version of House Bill 142. Chairwoman Roegner asked Representative Holmes to describe the substitute bill. Upon the substitute bill's description, Representative Wiggam spoke to the bill and answered questions from the committee. Chairwoman Roegner asked if there were any objections. Seeing none, Substitute Bill 0494-3 became the new working version of House Bill 142.

Jim Irvine of the Buckeye Firearms Association and Robert Cornwell of the Buckeye Sheriffs Association submitted written testimony.

Chairwoman Roegner called House Bill 253 for its 1<sup>st</sup> hearing.

Representative Householder and Representative Lanese presented sponsor testimony and answered questions from the committee.

Chairwoman Roegner adjourned the committee at approximately 4:00 PM.
