



House Federalism and Interstate Relations Committee

Minutes: September 19, 2017

Chairwoman Roegner called the meeting to order at 3:00 PM. The roll was called and a quorum was present. The minutes from the September 12, 2017 meeting were approved without objection.

Chairwoman Roegner called House Bill 142 for its 6th hearing.

Gary Witt presented opponent testimony on behalf of Ohioans for Concealed Carry and Chis Dorr presented opponent testimony on behalf of Ohio Gun Owners, and answered questions from the committee.

Jim Irvine presented proponent testimony on behalf of the Buckeye Firearms Association and answered questions from the committee.

Opponent written testimony was submitted by Chuck LaRosa on behalf of Ohioans for Concealed Carry and John Gilchrist on behalf of the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police. Proponent written testimony was submitted by Sean Maloney on behalf of the Buckeye Firearms Association.

Representative Lipps moved that the committee favorably report House Bill 142, as Substitute House Bill 142, out of committee. Chairwoman Roegner asked if there is any discussion. No discussion occurred. The clerk took the roll and House Bill 142 was favorably passed out of committee as Substitute House Bill 142 with a vote of 9 yeas and 2 nays.

Chairwoman Roegner called House Resolution 193 for its 1st hearing.

Representative Antonio presented sponsor testimony on behalf of herself and Representative Strahorn, and answered questions from the committee.

Chairwoman Roegner called House Bill 253 for its 2nd hearing.

Brian Steel presented proponent testimony on behalf of the Fraternal Order of Police and answered questions from the committee.
