BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4503.536 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4503.536. (A) Any person who has been awarded the	6
global war on terrorism civilian service medal may apply to the	7
registrar of motor vehicles for the registration of any	8
passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational	9
vehicle, or other vehicle of a class approved by the registrar	10
that the person owns or leases. The application shall be	11
accompanied by such documentary evidence in support of the	12
global war on terrorism civilian service medal as the registrar	13
may require. The application may be combined with a request for	14
a special reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or	15
4503.42 of the Revised Code.	16

Upon receipt of an application for registration of a motor	17
vehicle under this section and the required taxes and fees, and	18
upon presentation of the required supporting evidence of the	19
award of the global war on terrorism civilian service medal, the	20
registrar shall issue to the applicant the appropriate motor	21
vehicle registration and a set of license plates and a	22
validation sticker, or a validation sticker alone when required	23
by section 4503.191 of the Revised Code.	24
In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily	25
inscribed on license plates, the license plates shall be	26
inscribed with appropriate words indicating the applicable award	27
and bear a reproduction of the global war on terrorism civilian	28
service medal. The license plates shall bear county	29
identification stickers that identify the county of registration	30
by name or number.	31
The license plates and a validation sticker or, when	32
applicable, a validation sticker alone shall be issued upon	33
payment of the regular license tax required by section 4503.04	34
of the Revised Code, payment of any local motor vehicle license	35
tax levied under Chapter 4504. of the Revised Code, payment of	36
any applicable additional fee prescribed by section 4503.40 or	37
4503.42 of the Revised Code, and compliance with all other	38
applicable laws relating to the registration of motor vehicles.	39
The registrar shall not issue license plates under this	40
section unless the registrar first receives written permission	41
from the United States department of defense allowing the	42
registrar to place the image of the global war on terrorism	43
civilian service medal on the license plates.	44
(B) No person who is not a recipient of the global war on	45
terrorism civilian service medal shall willfully and falsely	46
