To repeal section 4121.351 of the Revised Code to 1
eliminate the ability of the Industrial Commission 2
to enter into personal service contracts during 3
hearing spikes, to make appropriations for the 4
Industrial Commission for the biennium beginning 5
July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, and to 6
provide authorization and conditions for the 7
operation of Commission programs. 8

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4121.351 of the Revised Code is 9
hereby repealed. 10

Section 2. All items in this section are hereby appropriated 11
out of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the 12
designated fund. For all appropriations made in this section, 13
those in the first column are for fiscal year 2016, and those in 14
the second column are for fiscal year 2017. 15

	act of the 131st General Assembly that applies generally to the			30

	Section 4. The provisions of law contained in this act, and			33
	their applications, are severable. If any provision of law			34
	contained in this act, or if any application of any provision of			35
	law contained in this act, is held invalid, the invalidity does			36
	not affect other provisions of law contained in this act and their			37
	applications that can be given effect without the invalid			38
	provision or application.			39
	Section 5. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this			40
	act, the sections of law contained in this act, and the items of			41

law of which the sections of law contained in this act are 44
composed, are not subject to the referendum under Ohio 45
Constitution, Article II, Section 1d and section 1.471 of the 46
Revised Code and therefore go into immediate effect when this act 47
becomes law. 48

Section 6. The amendment, enactment, or repeal by this act of 49
the divisions and sections of law listed below are subject to the 50
referendum under Ohio Constitution, Article II, Section 1c and 51
therefore take effect on the ninety-first day after this act is 52
filed with the Secretary of State: 53
