BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:	
Section 1. That section 107.22 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	3
Sec. 107.22. (A) As used in this section:	5
(1) "New American" means a person residing in this state who is not a United States citizen or United States national.	6 7
(2) "ESOL" means English for speakers of other languages.	8
(B) There is created in the governor's executive cabinet	9
the office for new Americans. The governor shall designate the	10
director of the governor's office for new Americans. The	11
director shall report directly to the office of the governor.	12
The director may appoint employees as are necessary to exercise	13
the powers and duties of the office.	14
(C) The governor's office for new Americans shall	15
represent the interests of new Americans in this state. The	16
duties of the director of the office shall include the	17
<pre>following:</pre>	18

(1) Increase access to ESOL training by engaging not-for-	19
profit organizations and other qualified providers for ESOL;	20
(2) Provide resources to new Americans for the	21
naturalization process and applications for deferred action for	22
childhood arrivals;	23
(3) Connect new Americans to resources that develop and	24
utilize their skills, employment referral programs, and other	25
workforce development programs;	26
(4) Encourage connections between new Americans and their	27
<pre>communities through the following:</pre>	28
(a) Advise the governor concerning matters affecting new	29
Americans in this state to encourage better participation of new	30
Americans in civic and economic opportunities;	31
(b) Assist local governments in developing activities to	32
enhance civic engagement.	33
(5) Strive to reduce exploitation of new Americans;	34
(6) Coordinate with state agencies to carry out the	35

(D) By the thirtieth day of June each year, the director	37
of the governor's office for new Americans shall deliver to the	38
governor and the general assembly an annual report that includes	39
an outline of any workforce programs utilized, a summary of	40
communication received through the office, and information on	41
ESOL training services provided.	42
