BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section	5
4503.901 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	6

treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall	8
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants	9

entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity	343
received from the fund during the previous calendar year.	344
Sec. 4503.901. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger	345
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other	346
vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles	347
may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle	348
and issuance of "Ohio Pupil TransportationSafety First!!!"	349
license plates. The application may be combined with a request	350
for a special reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or	351

state for deposit into the state treasury to the credit of the	384
license plate contribution fund created by section 4501.21 of	385
the Revised Code.	386
The registrar shall transmit the bureau of motor vehicles	387
administrative fee of ten dollars, the purpose of which is to	388
compensate the bureau for the additional services required in	389
the issuing of "Ohio Pupil TransportationSafety First!!!"	390
license plates, to the treasurer of state for deposit into the	391
state treasury to the credit of the state bureau of motor	392
vehicles fund created by section 4501.25 of the Revised Code.	393
(D) Sections 4503.77 and 4503.78 of the Revised Code do	394
not apply to license plates issued under this section.	395
Section 2. That existing section 4501.21 of the Revised	396
Code is hereby repealed.	397
