BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4/6/.03 be amended and section	5
4767.10 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 4767.03. (A)(1) The owner or the person responsible	7
for the operation and maintenance of a cemetery shall apply to	8
the division of real estate in the department of commerce to	9
register the cemetery on forms prescribed by the division. With	10
the application, the applicant shall submit the documentation	11
required in division (A) of section 4767.04 of the Revised Code	12
and a registration fee of twenty-five dollars for one cemetery,	13
forty dollars for two cemeteries, and fifty dollars for three or	14
more cemeteries, except that no fee shall be required of any	15
political subdivision.	
(2) The If the director of commerce, by rule adopted in	17
accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, may reduce the	18

amount of the registration fee required by this section in any	19
year if the director—determines that the total amount of funds	20
the <u>registration</u> fee <u>required by this section</u> is generating at	21
the amount specified by this section—exceeds the amount of funds	22
the division of real estate and the Ohio cemetery dispute	23
resolution commission created by section 4767.05 of the Revised	24
Code need to carry out their powers and duties under this	25
chapter, the director shall use the excess funds to provide	26
grants under the township abandoned cemetery maintenance grant	27
program created in section 4767.10 of the Revised Code. If the	28
director so reduces the amount of the registration fee, the-	29
director shall reduce it for all owners or other persons-	30
required to pay the fee under division (A) (1) of this section	31
and shall require that the reduced fee be paid according to the	32
number of cemeteries owned, operated, or maintained as required-	33
under that division. If the director has reduced the fee under	34
division (A)(2) of this section, the director may later raise it	35
up to the amounts specified in division (A)(1) of this section	36
if, in any year, the director determines that the total amount	37
of funds the fee is generating at the reduced amount is-	38
insufficient for the division of real estate and the Ohio	39
cemetery dispute resolution commission to carry out their powers-	40

(B) Upon receipt of the completed application form, 42 documentation, and, if required, registration fee, the division 43 of real estate shall issue a certificate of registration to the 44 applicant. The applicant shall display the certificate in a 45 conspicuous place on the premises of the cemetery for which the 46 registration was obtained, except that, if the applicant is the 47 governing body of a political subdivision or person acting on 48 behalf of that governing body, the certificate shall be kept on 49

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file and be available for public inspection at the office of the	50
governing body.	51
(C) Except as otherwise provided in this division, each	52
registration issued pursuant to this section shall expire	53
annually on the thirtieth day of June and may be renewed. The	54
renewal fee shall be the same as the initial registration fees	55
prescribed in division (A) of this section.	56
The registration of a cemetery operated and maintained by	57
a political subdivision shall not expire unless the political	58
subdivision ceases to operate and maintain the cemetery. A	59
political subdivision operating and maintaining a cemetery is	60
not required to renew or update the registration of that	61
cemetery unless there is a change in the information required	62
under division (A) of section 4767.04 of the Revised Code or	63
unless additional land is acquired to increase the size of the	64
cemetery.	65
(D) All registration and renewal fees collected pursuant	66
to this section shall be paid into the state treasury to the	67
credit of the division of real estate in the department of	68
commerce to be used by the division to carry out its powers and	69
duties under this chapter and by the Ohio cemetery dispute	70
resolution commission created by section 4767.05 of the Revised	71

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To be eligible to receive a grant, a board of township	80
trustees shall have one or more abandoned cemeteries in the	81
township, and insufficient funds to maintain the abandoned	82
cemetery or cemeteries.	83
A board of township trustees may apply for a grant under	84
the program by filing an application with the director of	85
commerce in a form prescribed by the director. The form shall	86
elicit facts establishing the township's eligibility for a	87
grant, and shall include a certification to be signed by a	88
majority of the board of township trustees or the township	89
administrator stating that, if received, all grant moneys will	90
be used only to pay for maintenance of the abandoned cemetery or	91
cemeteries in the township.	92
The director of commerce shall review an application to	93
determine whether the township is eligible for a grant. The	94
director shall make an eligibility determination, and shall	95
notify the board of township trustees in writing of that	96
determination within thirty days following receipt of the	97
application.	98
If the director approves an application, the director may	99
make grants in amounts to defray all or a part of the township's	100
expenses in maintaining the abandoned cemetery or cemeteries in	101
the township. The board of township trustees at reasonable	102
intervals shall report to the director on its use of the grant.	103
The director at any time may require the board of township	104
trustees to provide the director with an accounting of its use	105
of the grant. The director shall require the township to repay	106
any grant money that has been improperly used. If the township	107
has improperly used grant money, and fails to repay the	108
improperly used grant money within a reasonable time, the	109

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director has a cause of action to recover the improperly used	110
grant money. Upon the director's request, the attorney general	111
shall commence such an action and prosecute it to judgment.	112
The director of commerce may adopt rules under Chapter_	113
119. of the Revised Code that are necessary successfully and	114
efficiently to administer the township abandoned cemetery	115
maintenance grant program.	116
Section 2. That existing section 4767.03 of the Revised	117
Code is hereby repealed.	118
