#### A BILL

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

<b>Section 1.</b> That section 4501.21 be amended and section	4

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 21 pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 22 cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 23 programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 2.4 25 cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 26 the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 27 other abortion-related activities. 28
