BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.2296 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 5.2296. (A) The fourth Tuesday in September is
designated as "Voter Registration Awareness Day."

(B) On Voter Registration Awareness Day, state agencies,
political subdivisions, schools, and institutions of higher
education in this state are encouraged to offer the opportunity
to register to vote at their offices and to promote voter
registration on their official web sites and in other public
communications.
