## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section	5
4503.702 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state	7
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall	8
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants	9
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to	10
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.496,	11
4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 4503.505,	12
4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 4503.526,	13
4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552,	14
4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 4503.576,	15

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or other abortion-related activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends other money in that fund.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs and autism awareness efforts throughout the state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services directly to their clients.

The special bank account shall be separate and 181 distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 182 ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 183 for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 184 managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	329

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate	336
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than	337
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall	338
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this	339
section the investment income the fund earned the previous	340
calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an	341

entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity

received from the fund during the previous calendar year.

Sec. 4503.702. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger	344
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other	345
vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles	346
may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle	347
and issuance of Improved Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks	348
of the World (IBPOEW) license plates. The application for IBPOEW	349
license plates may be combined with a request for a special	350
reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the	351
Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application and	352
compliance by the applicant with this section, the registrar	353
shall issue to the applicant the appropriate vehicle	354
registration and a set of IBPOEW license plates with a	355
validation sticker or a validation sticker alone when required	356
by section 4503.191 of the Revised Code.	357
In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily	358
inscribed thereon, IBPOEW license plates shall bear the acronym	359
"IBPOEW" and a marking designed by the Ohio Association of the	360
Improved Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the World	361
that is approved by the registrar. IBPOEW license plates shall	362
bear county identification stickers that identify the county of	363
registration by name or number.	364
(B) IBPOEW license plates and validation stickers shall be	365
issued upon receipt of a contribution as provided in division	366
(C) of this section and upon payment of the regular license fee	367
required by section 4503.04 of the Revised Code, payment of any	368
local motor vehicle license tax levied under Chapter 4504. of	369
the Revised Code, payment of an additional fee of ten dollars,	370
and compliance with all other applicable laws relating to the	371
registration of motor vehicles. If the application for IBPOEW	372
license plates is combined with a request for a special reserved	373
license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised	374

Code, the license plates and validation sticker shall be issued	375
upon payment of the fees and taxes contained in this section and	376
the additional fee prescribed under section 4503.40 or 4503.42	377
of the Revised Code. The additional fee of ten dollars is for	378
the purpose of compensating the bureau of motor vehicles for	379
additional services required in the issuing of IBPOEW license	380
plates.	381
(C) For each application for registration and registration	382
renewal notice the registrar receives under this section, the	383
registrar shall collect a contribution of twenty-five dollars.	384
The registrar shall transmit this contribution to the treasurer	385
of state for deposit in the license plate contribution fund	386
created in section 4501.21 of the Revised Code.	387
The registrar shall transmit the additional fee of ten	388
dollars paid to compensate the bureau to the treasurer of state	389
for deposit into the state treasury to the credit of the state	390
bureau of motor vehicles fund created by section 4501.25 of the	391
Revised Code.	392
Section 2. That existing section 4501.21 of the Revised	393
Code is hereby repealed.	394
