To make supplemental appropriations related to 1
transportation for the biennium beginning July 1, 2
2015, and ending June 30, 2017, and to declare an 3
emergency. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. All items in this section are hereby appropriated 5
as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the 6
credit of the designated fund. For all appropriations made in this 7
act, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2016 and those 8
in the second column are for fiscal year 2017. The appropriations 9
made in this act are in addition to any other appropriations made 10
for the FY 2016-FY 2017 biennium. 11

Section 2. Within the limits set forth in this act, the 20
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 21
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 22
made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in which 23
appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures from 24
appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for as 25
though made in the transportation budget act of the 131st General 26
Assembly. 27

The appropriations made in this act are subject to all 28
provisions of the transportation budget act of the 131st General 29
Assembly that are generally applicable to such appropriations. 30

Section 3. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency 31
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 32
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to 33
authorize increased spending for transportation purposes as a 34
result of increased anticipated revenue. Therefore, this act shall 35
go into immediate effect. 36
