BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Money may be distributed to a school district	6	
under Section 2 of this act only upon the approval of an	7	
application submitted by the district. The State Board of	8	
Education shall prescribe an application form and establish	9	
criteria for the awarding of funds and procedures for the	10	
consideration and approval of applications.		
Section 2. All items in this section are hereby	12
