INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 226 - Representative Rogers.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lepore-Hagan, Sheehy.

To amend sections 5311.18 and 5312.12 of the Revised Code to provide that a portion of a condominium or planned community assessment is prior to other liens on condominium units and planned community lots and to provide that a condominium unit owners association lien is a continuing lien.

H. B. No. 227 - Representatives Roegner, Reece.

Cosponsors: Representatives Green, Brenner, Amstutz, Duffey, Lepore-Hagan, Rezabek, Kraus, Becker, Hood, Stinziano, Ginter.

To amend sections 2925.01, 4713.01, 4713.02, 4713.03, 4713.06, 4713.07, 4713.08, 4713.081, 4713.082, 4713.09, 4713.10, 4713.13, 4713.14, 4713.141, 4713.16, 4713.17, 4713.20, 4713.21, 4713.22, 4713.24, 4713.25, 4713.26, 4713.28, 4713.30, 4713.31, 4713.34, 4713.35, 4713.36, 4713.37, 4713.39, 4713.41, 4713.42, 4713.44, 4713.45, 4713.48, 4713.55, 4713.56, 4713.57, 4713.58, 4713.59, 4713.60, 4713.61, 4713.62, 4713.63, 4713.64, 4713.641, and 4713.99 and to enact sections 4713.071, 4713.66, and 4713.69 of the Revised Code to make changes to the Cosmetology Licensing Law.

H. B. No. 228 - Representative Cupp.

Cosponsors: Representatives Grossman, Hambley, Becker, Thompson, Ruhl, Schaffer, Conditt, Phillips, Blessing, Hackett, O'Brien, M., Amstutz, Buchy.

To amend sections 2981.01 and 2981.02 and to enact section 2917.48 of the Revised Code to prohibit the commission of any of a list of specified offenses by using a drone or by directing or supervising another person's use of a drone.

Said bills were considered the first time.
