## INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

# H. B. No. 234 - Representatives Johnson, G., Fedor.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antonio, Bishoff, Celebrezze, Clyde, Driehaus, Gerberry, Leland, Lepore-Hagan, O'Brien, S., Phillips, Ramos, Rogers, Stinziano, Sweeney, Sykes.

To amend sections 2901.13, 2907.02, 2907.03, and 2945.42 of the Revised Code to eliminate the period of limitation for the criminal prosecution of a person for rape, sexual battery, or complicity to commit rape or sexual battery, eliminate the spousal exceptions for the offenses of rape and sexual battery, and to permit a person to testify against the person's spouse in a prosecution for sexual battery.

## **H. B. No. 235** - Representative Terhar.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antani, Becker, Blessing, Brenner, Dever, Perales, Johnson, T., LaTourette, Maag, Romanchuk, Schaffer.

To amend section 2923.125 of the Revised Code to waive the concealed carry license fee for active members of the armed forces and retired and honorably discharged veterans and to accept military experience with firearms as proof of competency with firearms regardless of when the applicant for a license acquired the experience.

Said bills were considered the first time.
