### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 285** - Representative Sprague.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Bishoff, Blessing, Butler, Derickson, Dever, Ginter, Grossman, Hackett, Ryan.

To enact section 4729.40 of the Revised Code to authorize pharmacists to dispense multiple refills of a prescription simultaneously under certain circumstances.

**H. B. No. 286** - Representative Vitale.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Brenner, Brinkman, Butler, Conditt, Derickson, Ginter, Hayes, Henne, Hill, Hood, Kraus, McClain, Patmon, Perales, Retherford, Roegner, Romanchuk, Ruhl, Sprague, Terhar, Thompson, Young, Zeltwanger, Schaffer.

To amend section 3101.08 of the Revised Code to provide that an ordained or licensed minister or religious society is not required to solemnize a marriage and a religious society is not required to allow any building or property of the religious society to be used to host a marriage ceremony if the marriage does not conform to the ordained or licensed minister's or religious society's sincerely held religious beliefs, to provide that an ordained or licensed minister or religious society is not subject to civil or criminal liability for such a denial, and to provide that the state and political subdivisions may not penalize or withhold benefits to an ordained or licensed minister or religious society for such a denial.

**H. B. No. 287** - Representative Barnes.

To enact section 122.043 of the Revised Code to require the Director of Development Services to establish a youth summer jobs pledging initiative to increase access to summer employment opportunities for high school and college youth.

Said bills were considered the first time.
