INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 291 - Representatives Young, Dever.

Cosponsors: Representatives Blessing, Hambley, Hood, Bishoff, Schuring, Amstutz, Johnson, T., Grossman.

To amend section 2323.13 of the Revised Code to require notice and an opportunity for a hearing to a defendant before entry of judgment pursuant to a confession of judgment.

H. B. No. 292 - Representative Hagan.

Cosponsors: Representatives Patmon, Bishoff, Hambley, Grossman, Leland, Terhar, Manning, Perales.

To amend sections 124.42, 505.374, 505.375, 505.38, 709.012, 737.08, 737.22, 742.38, 4123.57, 4123.68, and 4766.09 of the Revised Code to provide that a firefighter who is disabled as a result of specified types of cancer is presumed for purposes of the laws governing workers' compensation and the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund to have incurred the cancer while performing official duties as a firefighter.

Said bills were considered the first time.
