**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 296** - Representative Young.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Boose, Brinkman, Buchy, Burkley, Green, Hill, Hood, Roegner, Schaffer, Thompson.

To enact section 4112.024 of the Revised Code to provide that a business is not required to participate in a ceremony creating a union between two persons of the same sex if such participation violates the business's right of conscience or freedom of religion.

**H. B. No. 297** - Representative Hill.

Cosponsors: Representatives Burkley, Hambley, Hayes, Derickson, LaTourette, Rezabek.

To amend section 5747.98 and to enact section 5747.052 of the Revised Code to authorize a refundable income tax credit for current livestock owners who invest in a manure storage or treatment facility or acquire manure application equipment or manure handling and transportation equipment.

**H. B. No. 298** - Representatives Schaffer, Maag.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antani, Becker, Blessing, Boose, Buchy, Ginter, Grossman, Hayes, Hood, Johnson, T., Koehler, Reineke, Retherford, Slaby, Sprague, Vitale.

To amend sections 4141.28 and 4141.29 and to enact section 4141.294 of the Revised Code to require applicants for unemployment benefits to submit to a drug test under certain circumstances, to require the Director of Job and Family Services to operate an Ohio Works First drug testing pilot program, and to make an appropriation.

Said bills were considered the first time.
